In his analysis, Patrick Dove seeks to create dialogues between literature and theoretical perspectives, including Continental philosophy, political thought, psychoanalysis, and sociology of globalization. The author highlights the connections between mass media, technology, politics, and economics. Patrick Dove is Associate Professor of Spanish at Indiana University and the author of *The Catastrophe of Modernity: Tragedy and the Nation in Latin American Literature*.
